Uniform Expectations and Dress Code

We expect our pupils at Smallthorne Primary to look smart at all times and to be appropriately dressed for school in line with this dress code.

Jewellery

Your child may wear a watch (not a smart watch). No necklaces, bracelets or rings for health and safety reasons. If your child wears earrings, they must be STUDS ONLY and your child must be able to take them out themselves for PE lessons. All pupils must take part in PE lessons, therefore, you will be expected to come to school to remove your child's earrings should the need arise. This also applies to swimming lessons.
