Mutual Respect

- PSHE curriculum – values the opinions of others
- Anti-bullying
- Online Safety
- RE curriculum – opinions and beliefs of others.
- Competitive sports
- School Council
- Promote good manners

Tolerance of Culture, Faith and Others

- Charity work – Children in Need, Coffee morning
- Festivals – Harvest
- RE Curriculum – covering a variety of religions

Personal Responsibility and Individual Liberty

- Understanding school and class rules – children encouraged to make the right choice and reflect on their choice and the effect it has on peers and adults.
- Pupil responsibilities – JLT, house captains, school council, sports leaders
- Online Safety – keeping safe and choosing not to share personal information.

- Behaviour Policy – traffic light system. Children to understand that behaviour has consequences, for themselves and others.
